TYPICAL SEQUENCE OF COURSES, IMPORTANT DATES, AND WEEKLY SCHEDULE

TYPICAL WEEKLY SCHEDULE: Mondays and Wednesdays OR Tuesdays and Thursdays for the Pre-Nursing Phase. Classes could meet up to four days a week for the Nursing Phase.

CLASS HOURS: 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

TRANSFER OF CREDITS: Science & English classes taken within 5 years or less with a “C” grade or above, and non-science classes taken with 7 years or less with a “C” grade or above from an accredited college or university will be considered for transfer.

SECOND YEAR ADMISSION: You must have a **2.75 GPA** or higher to be eligible to be considered to be admitted into the SECOND YEAR NURSING.
